

Lipscomb Academy Math Student's Job Description:

A math student who wishes to be successful will continually:

1. **Maintain good attendance** (math topics build)
2. **Remain focused and quiet in class** (don't waste yours or your classmates time)
3. **Attempt all Bell Work Problems** (these problems help review for the test)
4. **Do every night's homework assignment!**
5. **Check your answers for every assignment!**
6. **ASK QUESTIONS!** (No one can help you if you do not ask)
7. **Keep your notes, bell work, and homework organized.**
8. **Take COMPLETE Notes in class**
9. **Reference your notes when you "get stuck"** (notes are your "lifeline" when you are stuck on independent work)
10. **STUDY for your tests....by doing PRACTICE PROBLEMS**
11. **Study a little bit every night, or AT LEAST for several nights before the test....do not wait until the last night to cram.** (That is not a smart mathematicians strategy).
12. **ASK QUESTIONS!**
13. **"Bedside 5" – be willing to spend 5 minutes right before bed reviewing your mathematics** (helps convert that info. into long-term memory)
14. **Take ownership for your learning** (no one else can learn it for you)
15. **Get a good night's sleep.**
16. **Eat healthy and stay hydrated.**
